Press Note

- About 10,700 litres of liquor worth Rupees Sixty Lakh has been seized in State by the Static Surveillance Team and Flying Squad Teams since the announcement of elections.
- The cash seizer till date was 75 lakh and seizer of other items include 2000 T-shirts in Kolar city and 63 sarees in Magadi Taluk of Ramanagara District for violation of Model Code of Conduct.
- As a preventive measure u/s 107 CrPC, Fourteen Thousand Eight hundred and Seventy five persons have been bounded over and Seven thousand Three hundred and Eighty One cases have been booked.
- 1,954 cases valued at Rs. 7,37,176/- have been booked for violation of the provisions of the Karnataka Excise Act.
- Rs. 1.50 lakh cash in Mangalore, Rs. 1.8 Lakh cash in Ramnagar District and Rs. 3 lakh cash in Belgaum Rural District has been seized and FIRs have been filed since yesterday.
- Till today in all, 86 Nominations have been filed from 50 Candidates. Today 54 Nominations have been filed by 28 Candidates and 32 Nominations were filed from 22 Candidates yesterday.
- Prominent Candidates who filed Nominations today include Former C.M Shri. Dharam Singh from Bidar, Union Minister Shri. Mallikarjuna Kharge from Gulbarga, Former C.M B.S. Yeddiyuryappa from Shimoga, Former C.M Shri. Sadananda Gowda from Bangalore North, Union Minerster Veerappa Moily from Chickballapura.
