Alternative documents to establish identity for voting at biennial elections.

The Election Commission of India directs that all electors at the biennial elections in Karnataka South – East Graduates’ Constituency, Karnataka West Graduates’ Constituency, Karnataka North – East Teachers’ Constituency and Bangalore Teachers’ Constituency in the State of Karnataka, who have been issued with their EPICs, shall have to produce these cards to exercise their franchise, when they come to the polling stations for voting at the biennial elections to the Karnataka Legislative Council from the said Constituencies, notified on 27th May 2014. However, those electors who are not able to produce EPICs, will have to establish their identity, by producing any of the following alternative documents:-

1. Passport.
2. Driving License.
3. Service Identity Cards with photograph issued to employees by Central/State Government, Public Sector Undertakings/Public Limited Companies.
4. Passbooks with photograph issued by Bank/Post Office (Accounts opened on or before 31-05-2014).
5. Income Tax Identity Card (PAN card).
6. Aadhar Card.
7. Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR.
8. Health Insurance Scheme Smart Card with photograph (M/o Labour’s Scheme, issued upto 31-05-2014).
9. Pension document with photograph (issued upto 31-05-2014).
10. Freedom Fighter Identity Cards with photograph.
11. Arms Licences with photograph (issued upto 31-05-2014).
12. Certificate of physical handicap with photograph issued by the competent authority (issued upto 31-05-2014).
13. Ex-servicemen CSD Canteen card with photograph.
